## **Zero Conditional Clause**

-If / When + Present simple.

This conditional is used when the result will always happens.

It describes what happens in general

EX: "If water reaches 100 de-grees, it boils." (It is always true there cant be a different result sometimes).

## **First Conditional Clause**

It's used to talk about things which might happen in the future . Of course , we can't know what will happen in the future .

It describes a specific situation.

EX: If I study today, I'll go to the game tonight.
